Liaison Report. 30" minimum for One northern pike to go into effect April 1, 1997 approved by the LS Board of Directors.

Old Business.

1. Fish survey Sept 96. Collected less fish than other years. Major cause might be spawning. Same reports from other area lakes. Crappie population will recover with no stocking necessary. Al Pulley stated Lake Summerset appears to be the best Walleye lake in the state. Apparently lack of reproduction resulting in decline of the carp population.
2. Discussion on lake Weeds, no action.
3. Ice fishing. Some Crappies, bass, and walleye reported being caught, but not as much as other years.
4. Kreeel Fishing. Records will be started in the spring, various methods will be tried to mark fish tags and reported at the next meeting. Newspaper article will be issued when all information is compiled.
5. Fishing permit fees to be discussed at the Feb meeting.
6. State Officers are checking fisherman and advise they will check boats next summer.
