Old Business.

3. Lake weeds- are now disappearing causing brownish lake color.
4. Fish patrol. Ralph Lauren reported the Fish Patrol is active.

New Business.

1. Fish Shocking. No date at present, State Conservation Officer will advise the Chairman of the schedule. Chairman obtained names of committee members who maybe available for working on the shockings.
2. Fish Stocking. Shocking results will determine this years stocking requirements. Charlie Tannehill motioned to stock 500 Channel Catfish this year if shocking results indicate additional Channel Catfish should be added. Seconded by John Scaduto, motion carried.
3. Saugers. Chairman will discuss with State Officer if Saugers would be beneficial for LS fish population.
