LIAISON REPORT; No Board action required.

OLD BUSINESS:

1. Fish shocking and stocking. ~~1 hour~~ shocking first day account the generator failed. Completed the second day. Large amount of young fish were detected, but not many mature fish. State Conservation Officer definitely did not believe this was any problem indication. ^{15 min} 50 Silver minnows were stocked in April 1997, and a large amount were shocked up. State Conservation Officer suggested the following stocking. 2500 Walleyes, cost 85¢ each, 2800 small mouth bass, cost \$1.50 each, 1000-2800 channel catfish, cost 30¢ each. Availability of small mouth bass at the hatcheries will determine how many channel catfish will be purchased. ^{45 min}

4. Sauger Stocking. Not recommended by the State Conservation Officer.
