1. Chairman reported he tagged a 13 inch, 3/4 lb walleye on June 13 1997. Ray Piccioli caught this fish on May 13, 1998 and was 18 1/4 inches long, 2 3/4 lbs.

Crappies presently being caught are approximately 9 inches long, and are from the 1994 spawning. The 1997 spawning was exceptionally large and will reach legal size in 2001.
