

FISH CLUB MEETING NOV. 2, 1998

Meeting was opened at 7:05 P.M. Wally Radwin read the minutes from the last meeting. Minutes were approved.

For this meeting 18 members were in attendance. See attached list for names.

Wally reported on the following subjects:

- * 2800
2950 smallmouth bass were stocked on Sept 15 and were placed at the main marina.
- 5000 Cat fish were stocked at South Gate on Oct 15.
- Shocking results for Sept 28, were not yet available from Al Pully (DNR). Our evaluation is that weeds are definitely needed to protect small fish and to have a healthy lake, 10% of the lake should have weeds.
- Stated that 2" to 4" ^{BASS} ~~minnow~~ are being caught trolling and are being caught by the Dam at night. (Well-kept)
- Break away spillway net is not feasible for our Dam at this time. The net is still being tried at Shabbona Lake and the cost is \$3,000.

New Business:

- Conclusions is putting weeds in the Lake now, i.e., Lily pads, Cat tails etc. Charley stated our manager is familiar with the process and will ask him to make a presentation at one of our meetings.
- Requested to ask Al Pully to provide a letter to our association concerning the importance of having a minimum of 10% for the lake.
