

FISHING COMMITTEE MEETING

Frank Ascitutto motioned to accept the Jan 1999 meeting minutes as read, seconded by Joe Froehlich, motion carried.

Chairman Wally Raduns took over the Chairpersons position for the balance of the meeting.

Liaison report: No Board action required.

Old Business.

Cribs: Have materials for one more crib. Will assemble when weather permits.

Zebra Mussells: All boats by outside contractors for boat or dock placements must be washed before being put into LS. Security and maintenance will monitor. Also decided any boat trailers used only for transporting boats to LS must also be washed.

Chairman Wally Raduns introduced Alex Pulley, Illinois District Conservation Officer. Mr. Pulley covered the results of the Oct 28 1998 fish survey. The survey revealed large mouth bass are the most populous, and compares to Lake Carroll and Lake Galena. The Bluegill population might be controlled by the bass and appear to be declining every year. Discussed creel counts at various northern Illinois lakes. Our Crappie body conditions appear very good. Mr. Pulley complimented our Walleye stocking program. The 1998 survey revealed the following per centages of fish in Lake Summerset, Large Mouth bass and blue gills 91%, 1% Walleyes, 6% small mouth bass, 2 % Crappies, and 1% carp. The Chairman thanked Mr. Pulley for his expertise and endeavors to make Lake Summerset one of the better fishing lakes in the area.

John Scaduto motioned to adjourn,; seconded by Bill Keener, motion carried at 808PM.
