Meeting called to order by Walter Raduns at 702PM with Joe Kalasmiki, Dan Hayes, Gloria Tracy, Guest Ryan Honer, Ralph Lauren, Paul Brow, Ron Dobrunz, William Keener, John Farney, Dick Boitz, Ray Piccioli, Charlie Tannehill, Bill Kuta, Irv Folz, Orv Bergsmith, Bill Thomas, Joe Froehlich Frank Ascitutto, Tom Lydon, and Jim Deasey present.

Liaison Report, Charlie Tannehill, No Board Action required.

OLD BUSINESS

1. Cribbs. Temporary buoys broke from milk crate cribs during the winter. New buoys will be installed on a clear water day. Materials for additional cribs is on hand.
2. Fish Contest. June 19th, Charlie Tannehill handling. Ray Piccioli, Dick Boitz and Frank Ascitutto will assist.
3. Pancake breakfast. Volunteers appear to be the same as last year with a few exceptions.
4. LS Security patrols have been checking the dam fisherpersons.
5. Fish Patrol. Bill Kuta. Have 9 Volunteers, LS Security will handle a boat safety program for the volunteers. Some additional vests will be obtained. Fish patrol regulations and information for 1999 attached.
6. Fish Shocking May 27th. Al Pulley, Illinois Conservation Officer conducted the shocking. Adult bass 21 detected 14 inches or larger in 40 minutes, and 7 detected in 70 minutes during the 1998 Sept shocking. Walleyes, 6 17-18 inches with some 6 inch detected. Small mouth bass had some 4 inches detected. Many silver side and blunt nose minnows detected. Many small blue gills with some 9-10 inches long were shocked up. Sago pond weeds are coming up. next shocking September 1999.
7. Zebra mussells are being checked for, none detected.
8. Clarity and quality water tests for the state. The quality portion is eliminated this year.
9. Election of Officers.
Bill Keener nominated Joe Kalasmiki for Secretary, seconded by Ray Piccioli. Charlie Tannehill moved to close the nominations. Motion carried.
Joe Kalasmiki nominated Walter Raduns for Vice-Chairman, seconded by Dick Boitz, Charlie Tannehill moved to close the nominations, motion carried.
Irv Folz nominated Bill Kuta for Chairman, seconded by Tom Lydon.
Dick Boitz nominated Dan Hayes, seconded by Bill Keener, Charlie Tannehill moved the nominations be closed and a secret ballot be used. Charlie Tannehill and Walter Raduns handled the ballots with Dan Hayes being elected.

Chairman elect Dan Hayes stated he believed in teamwork and was looking forward to LS even being improved upon for fishing. His personal desire is to become a professional bass fisherman.

Ralph Lauren motioned to adjourn, seconded by Bill Keener, motion carried at 805PM.

All members shall have LSA identification cards in their possession while on patrol. When working with a partner they shall use their number together with their partners number as a team number for issuing citations. This will include the number of the boat patrol officer if teamed with that person.

Fishing regulations are contained in paragraph G , page 19 & 20, of the Red Book and on the official LSA size and possession limit card. These include all State of Illinois fishing regulations.

Red Book, Section M, page 24 & 25 details the authority of LSA security officers and can be used to write a citation for FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH A SECURITY OFFICER when confronted with an uncooperative individual. Red Book, Section B, paragraph C, page 3 SUPPLEMENTAL IDENTIFICATION is another enabling rule which can also be used with these individuals.

In the near future a portable radio and boat key will be kept at the guard office for our use. The radio should be in the possession of one team member when on patrol. Other recommended equipment is a clip board , ticket book, magic marker, measuring device and a camera.

When issuing a citation as much information as possible should be obtained. Do not check either box on the top line. Use team number only for ticketing staff person. Defendant is to be given white copy (original), pink and yellow copy turned in at guard house.

Each member of the fish patrol will be assigned a two week patrol period. They are to contact any other member they desire as a partner. These assignments will repeat when all members have been used up. If the schedule conflicts with work or vacation adjustments will be made upon notification. Please try to patrol once or twice during each week of your assigned time. Report any significant contacts to the fish patrol chairperson or at the fish club meeting.
