

FISH COMMITTEE MEETING

Jan 3, 2000

Meeting called to order at 7:02PM by ViceChairman Walter Raduns, with Joe Kalasmiki, Orwin Bergsmith, Duane Lundgren, Ron Dobrunz, Joe Froehlich, Ray Piccioli, Dick Boitz, Mike Glass, Ralph Lauren, John Scaduto, and Matt Sak present.

Ralph Lauren motioned to accept the December 1999 minutes as read, seconded by Dick Boitz, motion carried.

Liaison Report. John Scaduto advised any extra piers or docks ~~left~~ left over from the normal installation can be used for fishing docks.

Vice Chairman advised he discussed the Blue Gill population with the State Conservation Officer and was advised not to make any changes in the present situation.

O Bergsmith advised 16 inch and smaller Walleyes appear skinny, with the larger ones appearing fatter.

Stocking. 1800 Walleyes may arrive on Jan 5, and will be put in at the Southgate Marina.

Discussion held on Beach 2 parking.

Joe Froehlich motioned to obtain 6 Fishing Regulation and Limits signs for installation at Parks with fishing piers. Seconded by Ron Dobrunz motion carried.

Discussion on possibly change the Walleye season and closing in March and April. Further investigation on Walleye spawning to be made.

State fish survey revealed the following:

1. Bass spawn poor this year due to the weather.
2. Should stock 200 Tiger Muskies 12 inchers.
3. Should stock 2800 Walleyes, 6 to 10 inches next fall.
4. Small mouth bass. Give 1 more year to spawn prior to stocking.
5. Blue Gills sufficient.

Ralph Lauren motioned to sponsor adopt a muskie program at a cost of \$15.00 each, Seconded by Ray Piccioli, motioned carried with 4 opposed.

Visitors permit fishing and non Lake Summerset residence boats being brought in discussed.

ViceChairman questioned if any members were interested in a Lake Patrol Position, No response.

Ralph Lauren motioned to adjourn, seconded by Ray Piccioli, motion carried at 9:45PM.
