Ralph Lauren motioned to accept the Jan meeting minutes as read, seconded by Walter Raduns, motion carried.

Liaison Report: John Scaduto, nothing to report.

Fish Stocking: 1800 Walleyes were received Jan 17th. A total of 2800 walleyes have now been stocked in the last year for a total costs of \$6794.70.

Old Business.

1. Fishing Regulation Signs: on order and will be available soon.
2. Guests boats: A total of 18 were brought in during 1999, 14 fishing, 3 power, 1 sail, and 1 canoe. Walter Raduns advised the regulations state the lot owner must be present when the boat is in operation.

New Business.

1. LS Maintenance holding approx 20 xmas trees for us to tie up and use as fish cribs in LS.
2. DNR has been checking fisherpersons, but only enforcing State rules, not LSA if there is a difference. Chairman Bill Kuta to contact DNR requesting being informed when they are coming so some local representative could accompany them.
3. LS Office will be printing 2000 fishing regulations, there is no change from 1999.
4. Muskie Program. Discussed various methods of possible sources for assistance with the program.

The Fish Committee extends thier appreciation to the LS Maintenance Department for thier breaking up the thick ice at Southgate so the Walleye stocking could be accomplished.

Irv Folz motioned to request \$7500 for this years stocking programs. seconded by Don Dobrunz, motion carried, one opposed.

Ralph Lauren motioned to adjourn, seconded by Bill Keener, motion carried at 7:55PM.
