Wally Raduns motioned to accept the June meeting minutes as read, seconded by Ray Piccioli, motion carried.

Liaison Report. John Scaduto, nothing to report.

Old Business.

1. Fish Contest on 6-21-00. 21 enterants, 17 entered tagged bass contest, one caught by Mr. Kail, won \$34. Russ Preston caught 2 bass, 5 $\frac{1}{2}$  lbs, won \$52.50. Mr. Anderson caught 1 walleye 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  lbs won \$52.50. Fish Club netted \$160.
2. Red Book changes. Following turned in to Ruth Artisuk.
  - A. Boat docking at LSA piers and launching facilities be restricted to  $\frac{1}{2}$  hr and at no time shall a launching ramp to obstructed by a docked boat.
  - B. A person may use a bow & arrow and or spear for taking and eliminating carp from the lake. In addition to any required Ill or LSA license, such person shall have in his/her possession a valid permit issued by the LSA office for this purpose. The bows used shall be equipped with reel and line to recover arrows and restrict their flight.
3. Cribs: 6 cribs were made. LSA Manager does not want any cribs to be placed in any park waters. W Raduns to check out.
4. Lake Weeds. Ron Dobrunz advised the sub-committee checked out various lake locations, and are awaiting information on type of weeds are available.
5. Breakfast. Coffee makers, insect fogger to be delivered to Chairmans home. Set up will begin 1PM Friday.

New Business.

1. Fine Schudule. Security Sub-committee studied and recommended some new fine schedules, however they believed the fish club should decide if any changes in fishing violation fines should be made. Dick Boitz motioned to raise fines associated to fishing to \$40 for each incident. Seconded by Ray Piccioli, morion carried.

Bill Keener advised on 7-1 he observed a couple catching and keeping any size fish in large numbers, He notified security but there was no response.
