

FISH CLUB MEETING

Meeting called to order at 702PM by Chairman Bill Kuta with Tom Lydon, Joe Kalasmiki, John Scaduto, Mike Mazzaroli, William Keener, Duane Lundgren, Ervin Ewald, Ron Dobrunz, Ray Schafer, Arney Mesnard, Irv Folz, Gary Boeger, Joe Froehlich, Ray Tunelius, Alex Artisuk, Orvin Bergsmith, and Jeff Scaduto present.

William Keener motioned to accept the Dec 2000 meeting minutes as read, seconded by Irv Folz, motion carried.

Liaison Report: John Scaduto, nothing to report.

Orvil Bergsmith gave a presentation on ice fishing during Jan. 2001. Largest catfish caught was 25" 6½ lbs, next 24" 6 lbs, 22" 4½ lbs, 16" 1½ lbs. Overall ice fishing has not been good. Gary Boeger, Duane Lundgren and Jeff Scaduto also advised on their ice fishing.

Old Business:

1. Guest Speakers. Alec Pully will speak at the March meeting.
2. Lake Vegetation: Ron Dobrunz furnished the sub-committee's 5 page report. Estimated 3220 plants with a cost of \$825 needed. William Keener reported the Lake Planning Committee will have a Feb 24 meeting with the Fish Club sub-committee on the lake weeds. Ray Schafer motioned to accept the sub-committee's recommendations on the aquatic plants, quantity and expense, and to have them meet with the Lake Planning Committee, seconded by Irv Folz, motion carried.
3. Fish Stocking. Jeff Scaduto advised 17 to 19" muskies are available for \$14.00 each. State Conservation Officers recommended stocking for 2001 as follows: 2100 small mouth bass 4 to 6" long. 2100 to 4200 large mouth bass 4 to 6" long. 2100 Walleyes 7 to 10". Catfish not needed. Tiger Muskies will be needed. No aggressive fish are being stocked.
4. Cribs: Tom Lydon advised 6' X 6' pallets are available from the gas Company. Tom Lydon, Jeff Scaduto & Mike Mazzaroli to lineup pickup from the Gas Co and Milk crates from Dean Foods.

New Business:

1. Fishing trip to Lake Michigan. Trip suggested in early June or late July by Bill Kuta, cost approx \$55 per person. Will bring up again
2. at a later meeting for definite dates.

William Keener motioned to adjourn, seconded by Tom Lydon, Motion carried at 750PM.
