## OLD BUSINESS

Mike suggested that it would be a good idea if Wally again printed the map he had previously shown in the LS paper. Alex suggested that job descriptions be made and given to the men who are our lake patrol. Joe believes that another way that we can help this situation is to have a fish survey. Another suggestion was to get volunteers to go out on boat patrol with the LS fish patrol.
